In order to further promote PWN's goal of women helping women, the Professional Women's Network will award up to four (4) scholarships of approximately \$500 for the academic year 2016-207 to women students.

To qualify you must:

- (1) Be a resident of Iowa, or a Professional Women's Network member, or be referred by a Professional Women's Network member;
- (2) Be female;
- (3) Be a student who will be attending classes, either full or part-time, during academic year 2016-2017 (special consideration will be given to non-traditional students, defined as women 21 years of age or older upon application, who have or will return to school after an absence of at least three years);
- (4) Be working toward an associate or undergraduate degree or vocational certification; and
